



New Meal Charging Policy

Students are only allowed to charge up to five meals (breakfast and/ or lunch). Once the account reaches that threshold, the student may not eat a school meal until they bring the account up to balance or bring money for the meal. Reminder notices will be sent to parents when student meal account balances are low.

If certain income guidelines are met, school-age children may qualify for free or reduced price meals. Contact either school office for more information. Your inquiry and meal status will be handled in the strictest confidence.
